

# TimeoutTrack Privacy Policy

Last updated and effective: August 22, 2022

This Privacy Policy applies to the Discord bot: TimeoutTrack#2203

## Data Usage

### Storage

TimeoutTrack does *not* store any Discord data by default, it stores the following Discord data provided in the **/setup** command:

- **Server ID:** This is stored and used to link the saved data to your server and provide functionality.
- **Channel ID:** This is stored and used for channel you want logs regarding timeouts to be sent.
- **Role IDs:** These are stored and used to identify roles (up to 3) the server moderators want to be considered "mod" and can modify the settings of the bot.

### Usage

In addition to the above, TimeoutTrack processes the following Discord information, but does not store it:

- **Member Updates:** This data is only used for detecting when a user has been timed out.
- **Message Content:** This data is used for Discord AutoMod related timeouts to be able to DM timed out users the word in their message that called for their timeout.

### Non-Discord Data


The following is information that doesn't come from Discord, but is stored and linked to a server:

- **DM preferences:** If a server moderator sets up automatic DMs for a timeout, that preference will be stored until the **/view\_setup** command is ran and a moderator presses the **Clear DM Preferences** button.
